- ALL ENTRIES WILL BE **SUBMITTED DIGITALLY** VIA A **GOOGLE FORM** (LINK BELOW). PLEASE ATTACH A PHOTO OF YOUR STUDENT'S ARTWORK TO THE FORM.
- CATEGORIES ARE LIMITED TO **VISUAL ARTS & PHOTOGRAPHY**.
- JUDGING WILL TAKE PLACE REMOTELY. ARTWORK WILL NOT BE DISPLAYED AT THE SCHOOL THIS YEAR.

NOTE: Please save your student's original artwork. Following the initial round of judging, we will contact those students advancing to the district level with additional information.

FAQs

- Q: May I email, text or hand deliver my student's entry?
A: No, entries will only be accepted via the Google form (Link Below).

- Q: My student has entered in the Dance/Film/Literature/Music category in the past. Can he/she enter in the same category this year?
A: Unfortunately, only **Visual Arts and Photography** entries will be accepted this year.
- Q: Can my student enter in the same category multiple times and/or both categories one or more times?
A: Yes, there is no limit to the number of entries each student can submit; however, a separate Google form must be filled out for each entry.
- Q: I am not a current PTA member. Can my student participate in the program?
A: No, one parent/caregiver must be a current PTA member for a student to participate. (Please email cynthiaclane@hotmail.com for instructions on how to join the Frostwood PTA.)
- Q: I have a student with a disability. Is there a category specifically designed for him/her?
A: Yes, there is a Special Artist category. Please refer to the program rules (Link Below).
- Q: Do I also need to fill out the entry form in the "Rules" PDF attached?
A: No, you only need to fill out the Google form (Link Below).
- Q: I have a student at another school that is allowing entries in categories other than Visual Arts and Photography. Why can't my FWE student enter in other categories?
A: The decision to only allow Visual Arts and Photography entries is specific to FWE and was made with students' and judges' safety in mind.
